**Agape Meal.** The Agape meal/service was enjoyed by 32 people at Woodstock last week. A hot meal was provided using some hotplates kindly donated to the church. £95 was raised and has been given to the Christian Aid Middle East Crisis fund. With the final totals in from The Passion play that brings our donation up to £433 to Christian Aid.

**Woodworm** was found in the bell tower in Woodstock. The whole church has been surveyed and no other active woodworm has been found. The offending area has been treated along with the ladder to the roof. We were told that this originated from some wood introduced to the Carillon (the mechanism that rings the clock music chimes) cupboard added years ago that was infested.
